Boomer

HIGH YIELD • WINTER HARDY

Boomer is a high yielding, winter hardy, true semi-dwarf, hard red winter wheat. Boomer is medium maturity and has excellent winter hardiness for improved spring recovery and ground cover. Boomer provides excellent potential for intensive management programs and performs well under dry-land production systems. Boomer has excellent leaf rust resistance, has good stem rust resistance and is moderately susceptible Fusarium head blight and leaf foliar diseases.

MANAGEMENT STRATEGY

Minnesota / North Dakota / South Dakota

1. Plant **Certified seed** 1-2 inches below the soil surface.
2. Plant at a rate of 1,000,000 – 1,500,000 live plants per acre depending on planting date and stubble.
3. To maximize economic yields, apply adequate levels of nutrients based on soil fertility and yield goal recommendations. An 80 bushel yield target is a good starting point for Boomer. In general, 2.5 pounds of Nitrogen per bushel of expected yield should be applied. Make sure that Sulfur levels are in balance with Nitrogen; 5N:1S in the soil and 10N:1S in plant tissue is recommended.
4. Boomer is moderately susceptible to Fusarium head blight (scab) and foliar diseases. Boomer should be treated with fungicide at the 4-5 leaf stage and at flowering.
