

CDC FALCON

HARD RED WINTER WHEAT



CDC Falcon is a high yielding, winter hardy, semi-dwarf, hard red winter wheat. CDC Falcon is medium maturity and has excellent winter hardiness for improved spring recovery and ground cover. CDC Falcon provides excellent potential for irrigated and intensive management programs and performs well under dry-land production systems. The variety also possesses short stiff straw for zero or minimum tillage systems. CDC Falcon has good stem rust resistance, is moderately susceptible to leaf rust and is susceptible to Fusarium head blight.

MANAGEMENT STRATEGY

Minnesota / North Dakota / South Dakota

1. Plant **Certified** seed 1-2 inches below the soil surface.
2. Plant at a rate of 950,000 – 1,250,000 live plants per acre.
3. To maximize economic yields, apply adequate levels of nutrients based on soil fertility and yield goal recommendations. An 80 bushel yield target is a good starting point for CDC Falcon. In general, 2.5 pounds of Nitrogen per bushel of expected yield should be applied.
4. CDC Falcon is susceptible to Fusarium head blight (scab). Where scab is a problem, CDC Falcon should be treated with fungicide at the 4-5 leaf stage and at flowering.
